# Improving Focus Starts in Fun Practice

**H**ooked on phonics was fun and it helped kids focus and learn to read. Now they can get hooked on Snag and get the feel for the game of golf. The Snag experience is a "Fla sticky", which is the

focus point on an above-ground weighted cylinder covered with a hook. A Snag ball which is slightly smaller than a tennis ball, covered with a loop material; and a club called The Launcher are the tools needed to chip, swing smash and stick. The only goal is to stick your ball on the Flagsticky.

Just as you may notice the PGA Tour, pros have all different types of mechanics but they all hit the ball well. They all have practical practice drills which focus on the feel of impact through the ball. Snag not only gives you feel, it ingrains a desire to hit the ball and stick the Flagsticky. Snag is making practice fun and helps young golfers develop swing mechanics for the future.
